

# HELP FOR METRONOME

**PURPOSE:** The Metronome is used by musicians to mark time at a selected rate.

---

## When to Use the Metronome

Use this screen when you want to use the Metronome to assist with keeping steady time.

## Why would you want to do that?

If you are practicing playing a musical instrument you can use the Metronome to help you maintain a steady timing.

## How to Use the Metronome

**Use the Slider to set Beats Per Minute (BPM)** – Slide the slider back and forth to select the BPM.

Depending on the device and the physical conditions it can be difficult to use the slider to set the exact BPM. The +/- buttons can be used to get the exact BPM you want.

**Use the Slider to set Beats Per Measure** – Slide the slider back and forth to select the Beats Per Measure. Instead of just using the BPM timer you can align the intervals with a measure. The sound played on the first beat of the measure can be set to a different sound than the other beats for that measure. This can make it easier to identify measure boundaries.

Depending on the device and the physical conditions it can be difficult to use the slider to set the exact Beats Per Measure. The +/- buttons can be used to get the exact BPM you want.

**Tap Start to start the Metronome** – Start it.

**Tap Stop to stop the Metronome** – Stop it.

**Use the Picker to Select a sound for Beat 1 or for the Other beats** – Rotate the Picker by swiping to select the sounds that meet your need.

A standard Metronome will simply make an audible Tick on each beat. This Metronome also has a silent **Red Dot** that can be used to indicate the beat. It may be difficult to see the **Red Dot**, in which case you might want to use the **Flash** option to use the **Flash** instead. With the **Flash** you don't have to be looking directly at it to see the beat. In fact you should avoid looking directly at it because it is very bright. The Flash will not be available on all devices.

**NOTE: The flash is very bright – avoid looking directly at it.**

**Use the Sound Button** to turn the Sound Off or On

**Use the Red Dot Button** to turn the Red Dot Off or On

**Use the Flash Button** to turn the Flash Off or On (Not available on all devices)

**Tap Back to return to the Main Menu**



